**Tee Times:** It is recommended that members and guests make tee times through the pro shop to help the staff better assist them when they arrive. . **Member Sign In:** All members should sign in before play. We need this information so we know who is on the course in case of emergencies. PLEASE PRINT YOUR NAME

**Golf Cart Rules & Regulations:** Please be advised that carts must remain on the cart paths on all Par 3's. Also, please try to avoid driving and parking carts on extreme inclines to avoid turf damage. New cart signs have been placed on hole #9 to help preserve the course during wet conditions.

**Cart/Bag Storage:** The Pro shop is offering cart and bag storage for the 2013 season. The annual cost will be \$50. If your bags/carts are stored, we ask that you please notify the pro shop that you are on your way to the club to play, so we can set up your equipment for your round.

**Pro shop Credits:** *\*Important\* All 2012 pro shop credits will expire on June 1<sup>st</sup> and may only be used towards the purchase of 2012 merchandise.* 2013 credits can be used on any and all purchases made through the pro shop towards golf merchandise including special orders up until July 1<sup>st</sup>. Gift certificates must be presented at the time of purchase. The pro shop is not held responsible for lost pro shop credits.

**Demo Clubs:** Demo clubs are available in the pro shop for testing. Please sign out the desired club with the golf staff. Demo clubs must be returned immediately following the conclusion of play or practice and be put back into inventory.
